Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project outcomes. What was done (in 100 words or less)? Vocational scholarships were awarded to 5 Fountain Hills residents for the 2025 Spring Semester at Scottsdale Community College.

When (dates) and where (city, state and country) did project activities take place?

The SCC is in Arizona. The Spring Semester began in January and will end in mid-May 2025.

Who were the beneficiaries? The scholarship recipients were 5 young adults who reside in Fountain Hills, AZ. Two are pursuing degrees in Business Administration. One student is focused on Criminal Justice, another is interested in Computer Science. The fifth student wants a career involving Diagnostic Medical Sonography.

- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? Seven Rotarians were active in screening candidates and interfacing with the college administrative staff.
- 3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Initially, the Rotarians had to develop an advertising plan to reach potential candidates. This involved interaction with local college administrative staffs, community service clubs, counselors at the high school, etc. Potential candidates are then interviewed by 3 or 4 Rotarians. After the screening and selection process is completed, contact with the financial officers at the local Community Colleges and vocational institutions e.g., EVIT, is established and payment is made for the committed amount.
- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Five students and their families were the direct beneficiaries.

- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? We have found a substantial local interest and financial need in very bright and motivated adults who desire to improve their education and technical skills to help them reach and serve beyond what a high school diploma will provide.
- 6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Councilors at Fountain Hills High School and Scottsdale Community College provided guidance throughout the process.
