1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?						

Youth Fishing Derby: Held on the Seal Beach Pier, this annual event attracted nearly 300 school-aged children who are accompanied by their

parent/caregivers. Children came from surrounding communities to enjoy a morning of fishing and vie for trophies and prizes in 3 age groups. Interact Club Support: Our club is closely engaged with the Interact Clubs at Los Alamitos High School and Cypress High School. Rotary members ordered, picked up, delivered and served pizza at each of the Interact Club meetings.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

Approximately 25 members participated in the Fishing Derby and over the course of the year, 6 Rotarians delivered pizza to the Interact Club.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Fishing Derby: Registered participants, cut bait, weighted catches and otherwise interacted with anglers and their parents.

Interact Club Support: Ordered, picked up, delivered and served pizza as well as participated in club discussions.

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

Fishing Derby: 300 children plus at least and equal number of adults.

Interact Club Support: 50 Interact Club members and their advisor.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Fishing Derby: Participants interacted with Rotarians thus strengthening the community awareness of Rotary's social impact within the community. Families with limited resources or access to fishing and our natural resources were able to share a no-cost, healthful, enjoyable day bonding with both the community and their own families.

Interact Club Support: Interact meetings are designed for Interact Club members to gather during school lunch periods, to engage in common projects, team building and to share information about important issues while also serving as outreach for recruiting new members.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

The Seal Beach Lions Club coordinated their own event to serve a no-cost pancake breakfast to Fishing Derby participants and their parents/guardians.
