Ref: January 2025 Food, toys and blanket project

Dear Gillian:

Reference is hereby made to the annual program hosted and promoted by our Rotary Club in Ensenada, Baja California, Mexico (District 4100) in regards to the distribution of food, blankets and toys throughout the most needing urban communities in our City.

This year, as it has occurred in former years, San Clemente Rotary Club has contributed both with economic and individual work-service in the food toys and blanket project organized and held by our Club during January 10 and 11. This program has been going on for more than 30 years; this year we were able to donate to more that 1,000 food baskets-bags and blankets to families in our community, with a cost of each food basket and blanket in excess of US\$22.00 Dollars, that in addition to the toys and clothing donated by many Rotarians.

This year San Clemente Rotary Club contributed with US\$2,000.00 Dollars to buy food and blanket; our food basket is comprised of the following items and costs:

- a) 1 kilogram of Sugar
- b) 4 cans of tuna (donated by other Rotary Club)
- c) 1 liter of vegetable oil



- d) 1 kilogram of rice
- e) 1 kilogram of beans
- f) 1 liter of milk
- g) 400 grams of oatmeal
- h) 1 kilogram of wheat flour
- i) 1 kilogram of corn flour
- j) 400 grams of canned vegetables
- k) 2 cans of tomato puree
- l) 2 bags of pasta
- m) 1 can of cured green peppers
- n) 1 can of yellow corn
- o) 1 Blanket

The cost of this food basket and blanket is \$423.72 Pesos per bag (excluding the tuna), at an estimated exchange rate of \$19.00 Pesos, per dollar, results in a cost per basket of US\$22.30 Dollars. Therefore, the San Clemente Rotary Club contribution helped us with approximately 90 food bags-baskets.
