


1. How many years in Corazon

- Among the 21 respondents from the Flores Magon community, 4 of the community members have been apart of Corazon for 10+ years, while 2 community members have been in Corazon for about 7-9 years, 1 community member has been involved for 4-6 years, and the majority, 14 community members, have joined more recently and have been in Corazon for about 1-3 years.
- When asked how many years they have been a part of Corazon, only 2 members of the Nuevo Milenio community have been a part of Corazon for 10+ years, while 1 member has been a part of Corazon for 7-9 years, and 15 members have only been a part of Corazon for 1-3 years.
- When asked how many years they had been apart of Corazon, 6 of the Cumbres community members responded that they had been apart of Corazon for 10+ years, while 1 community member responded with 7-9 years, 2 community members stated that they had been apart of Corazon for 4-6 years, and the remaining 7 community members stated they had only been apart of Corazon for 1-3 years.
- When the Canon Carretas community was asked how many years they had been in Corazon, 2 of the community members had responded that they had been apart of Corazon for 10+ years, while 2 members stated they have been in Corazon for 7-9 years, 4 members have been in Corazon for 4-6 years, and 14 members have only been in Corazon for 1-3 years.


2. Needs Septic Tank

- When the Cerro Azul community was asked if they needed a septic tank, 17 of the community members said they did need a septic tank, while the remaining 17 members responded that they did not or that they already had a septic tank.
- When the Valle de las Palmas community was asked if they would need a septic tank, 9 of the community members responded with yes, while 8 responded that they would not.




3. Your area has access to municipal water and sewage connection

- When asked this on the survey, 11 of the Nuevo Milenio community members stated that they did have access to municipal water and sewage connection, while 7 community members said they did not.
- When the Cumbres community was asked if their area had access to municipal water and a sewage connection, 12 of the community members said that they did, while 4 community members stated that they did not.
- When asked if their area had access to municipal water and sewage connection, 18 of the Canon Carretas community members stated that they did have access to municipal water and sewage connection, while only 4 community members stated that they did not.
