48 Rotarians from 9 clubs in District 5320 traveled by bus on 3/29/2025 from Orange County to a rural village named Cerro Azul approx. 12 KM south of Tecate, BC, Mexico, built a 16' X 20' house and awarded it to a worthy family who earned it by contributing 100s service hours to Corazon Community projects

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples. There were hammerers, painters, wood cutters, roofers & cheerleaders

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? Most directly, the family of four who moved in right after we finished it. The cost of every house also includes a donation to the Corazon Scholarship fund and every child must be enrolled in school in order for families to be members in good standing of the Corazon Community. So, every child getting a books/uniform scholarship (most) benefits and arguably, the entire community, state, country, world benefits from better educated occupants. Additionally, the human shelter this house provided benefits the family moving into it in many, many ways.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Healthier, better educated citizenry being given the chance to break the cycle of generational poverty. From a sanitation perspective, we are lifting them from the 19<sup>th</sup> to the 20<sup>th</sup> Century with all the health and quality of life benefits that go with it.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Corazon does a stellar job of managing all transportation, materials and logistics. They are a perfect Rotary partner.
