On November 25th at Vista Del Camino in Scottsdale, Arizona ,12 of our club members participated in sorting all the items into bins and making up packets to fill 150 backpacks for their unsheltered outreach program. We also were able to sort and hang donated clothing for the unsheltered.

Some of the items were purchased by our members prior to going to Vista on that same day.
