1. Briefly describe the project outcomes. What was done (in 100 words or less)? 1. Rose Beds concrete edgers were raised / leveled to contain new fill materials 2. Metal signage was raised higher to be seen 3. Installed four catch basins at the ends of the broken transfer pipes / safety issue 4. Painted three low walls used for seating 5. Painted the Kiosk and Roof – large trees had been removed due to limbs falling onto the roof / removed damaged ridge trim & top cap / repaired / reinstalled / painted & the damaged plastic panels were replaced in the doors 6. Extended several water pipe risers to install electronic – self watering devices above the flood irrigation level 7. Erosion Control / installed river rocks / ABC & dirt 8. Trimming (dead heading) of rose bushes / Weeding.

Started late July 2024 to mid-March 2025 – Mesa Community College – Mesa, AZ., USA.
