Our club has an ongoing relationship with Richard J. Wilson Elementary, a Title One, multilingual school that is part of FWISD. The administration requested that we purchase key equipment and materials to enhance their recently adopted use of the RCA House System, a school wide approach to improving their student academic and behavioral outcomes. The purchases, including multiple electronic screens, lightening, backdrops, and banners, arrived and were installed in January.

Our club members maintain relationships with schoolteachers and administrators for the purpose of organizing projects and support throughout the year. In addition to the grant, we host academic recognition events following each marking period, host a teacher appreciation and provide a bike-give-away at the end of the school year.

The principal of RJWilson spoke to our club in early 2025 about the impact of our grant. He explained how the items purchased provide daily reinforcement of the program objectives. He brought photos of the electronic equipment in use at the school. The principal shared the school's academic ratings per grade level in multiple subject areas from the previous school year. At the end of the current school year, ratings will be compared to help measure the effectiveness of the new approach.

Our club is supporting the efforts of Richard J. Wilson Elementary to complete an overhaul of their school environment both academically and culturally. We applaud their efforts and look forward to learning more about the results following completion of this school year.
