

REHABILITATION OF ABESIM PRESBY B JHS, SUNYANI, GHANA

The Abesim Presby B Junior High School (JHS) is located in Abesim, a town next to Sunyani in the Bono Region of Ghana. It has a total student population of 670 made up of 321 boys and 349 girls. The JHS provides continuation for the primary school and feeds the Senior High Schools in the basic and secondary education system in Ghana.

On March 3, 2023, a rainstorm ripped off the whole roof of the JHS building and left the classes at the mercy of the weather. The rainstorm also destroyed textbooks and other teaching and learning materials. The students had to be distributed to the Presby A stream resulting in congestions and increased class sizes. This is causing many challenges for class management and supervision for effective teaching and learning.



This project is meant to re-roof the 4-unit classroom block, strengthen the columns, repair the floors of the classrooms and veranda, fix the damage windows and doors, provide ceiling to the classrooms, electrical installation, supply textbooks and provide teacher fresher training to the teachers to enhance teaching and learning and improve upon learning outcomes. The total cost of the project is estimated at **USD30,300. Minimum for global grant.**

Our school building which was the hub of our educational endeavours, was unfortunately demolished by heavy rainstorm on the 3rd of March, 2023, leaving us with a significant challenge to continue our operations.

The devastating storm destroyed our four – unit classrooms, textbooks, learning materials and aids coupled with other important materials just to mention a few. Our students and staff are currently without a safe and conducive learning environment, and we urgently need support to reconstruct our school building.

We require financial aid to cover the costs of:


- Rebuilding the demolished structure
