Project summary 2017-2022

Out of the 149 graduates:

- 61 % work in nursing
- 16 % work in daycare
- 22 % work in elderly care
- 1% care for sick relatives.

Our new goal is to provide training for approximately 150 women

We achieved something truly remarkable together. Thanks to your generous donations, we were able to give 149 young mothers in the slums of Manila a chance at a better life. This incredible project was made possible through your support, as well as the contributions of many clubs and Rotary International.

These women have completed training to become caregivers, which has not only given them the opportunity to support their families but also to fund their children's education.

For example, the son of one of the graduates from 2017 earned his bachelor's degree in computer science last month → E a further success.

The journey was not easy. In the beginning, many of these women doubted whether they would be able to complete the training. But with their determination, the dedicated teacher, and the tireless efforts of the on-site project team, they succeeded—and with flying colors. Today, they are not only trained caregivers but also confident women who can independently support their families.

This success would not have been possible without your help. However, our work is not finished. Many more young mothers are still waiting for their chance to break the cycle of poverty and create a better future for themselves and their children.
