I. Progress Update on Construction of Classrooms

<u>Construction Status as of January 2012</u>: Phase 2A of Construction on the classrooms has been completed as a result of 2400 USD in funding donated by the San Diego Downtown Breakfast Rotary Club.

Step 1: Large rocks were broken and fitted into place as the first layer of the floor.





<u>Step 2</u>: Gravel was spread across the large rocks to fill any gaps.





<u>Step 3</u>: Concrete was mixed on site using Cement, Aggregate (rocks about 1 to 2 inches in diameter), Sand, and water.









Step 4: The concrete mixture was deposited and leveled uniformly.





The Completed Flooring





*Please note: When the walls are plastered in Construction Phase III, a final coat of concrete plaster will be put on the floor as well.

Phase Summary: Approximately **\$1,850 USD** was used to complete Phase 2A, just slightly above projected costs.

III. Phase 2B Financial Summary

Of the initial \$2,400 USD donated by the San Diego Downtown Breakfast Rotary Club, approximately \$550 USD remains and has been allocated to completing Phase 2B of construction (Roofing). Construction is currently on hold until complete funding can be acquired, as the roofing phase must be begun only when all funding required for completion is available. If the roofing is left unfinished and exposed to the elements for an extended period of time, its integrity may be compromised.

The projections for Phase 2B construction costs are as follows:
