Project Description:

The Four Greeley Rotary Clubs used their Centennial Grants to provide tables and audio-visual equipment for the new educational facility at the Poudre Learning Center. The tables have been purchased, are paid for and in storage waiting for use in the new building. A projector and large screen have been ordered and the screen has been delivered. The projector has not been received. No billing has been received for the projector equipment. We expect delivery of the projector within the next week. We should then be able to finalize these three projects.
