The Greeley Redeye Rotary Club, as part of its literacy project, supported the purchasing of books for a class at Billie Martinez Elementary School through the non-profit The Book Trust. This organization provides books to low-income students that they can own and take home. This is an effort to improve literacy in young children and encourage them to read at home. We were scheduled to be at the school when the class received the books and read to the students. This was to occur in the Spring of 2020. Because of COVID-19, this could not occur.

Volunteers are still not allowed in schools, but we will reschedule a reading activity at the earliest possible convenience.
