Project Title: New Mommy Basket Project

Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The district grant and club match were donated to Health Services of North Texas (HSNT), a Denton, Texas nonprofit agency that cares for 12,000+ lower income people every year. The money was used by HSNT to purchase baby care supplies along with baby care information to new mothers that HSNT serves. The supplies included diapers, wipes, a onesie, burp cloth, receiving blanket, Kind bar, Aquaphor lip repair, infant socks, body lotion, hand knitted infant cap, water bottle, and *Goodnight Moon* board book, all in a carry tote bag. The grant monies helped cover the cost of 88+ tote bags with supplies, which is around half a year's supplies for HSNT. In addition to the grant-funded items, an Amazon purchasing site was established so that Denton Rotary Club members and additional clubs, and other donors could purchase more supplies for use in the rest of the year. That effort increased the total supplies so that an entire year's supply of tote bags (175) was created. This grant strongly centered on Rotary's Maternal and Child Health Area of Focus as well as Disease Prevention and Community Economic Development.

This project provided baby care items and postnatal health information to low-income mothers currently from homes stressed by the economic downturn caused by the Covid-19 pandemic, helping to alleviate the additional strain on low-economic families who also face employment, rental, and medical financial difficulties resulting over the 2020-21 pandemic period. The project will help facilitate newborn and post-delivery maternal care for over 175 households in the Denton, Texas County area.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Using the grant monies, Health Services of North Texas organized the purchase of baby and new mother care items and prepared the new mother educational information that was included in the


supply tote. They serve and have access to those low-income mothers who can benefit the most from the project supplies.
