- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries:
Club members purchased, decorated, stuffed, and delivered more than 200 "Sweet Cases;" duffel bags that are given to children in the foster care system so they can pack their personal items in something other than a trash bag. Purchase of the bags occurred late 2021, while decorating occurred in February of 2022 at the Boys & Girls Club of La Habra. More than 25 Boys & Girls Club members and Rotarians assisted in the decorating and stuffing. Bags were delivered to Wayfinder Family Services (Whittier) on March 2, 2022. WayFinder has direct access to the children who will benefit from the "Sweet Cases."
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? 8
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples. Rotarians decorated the bags, then stuffed them with personal needs for the children. Rotarians also assisted in delivering bags to a distribution agency.
- How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 240. This includes the volunteers AND the recipients of the bags.
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Children in the foster care system that receive the bags will potentially benefit for a lifetime, knowing that individuals care about them enough to provide them with something tangible that they can call "mine."
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Bags were purchased from Together We Rise. Boys & Girls Club of La Habra provided the space for the project and additional volunteers. WayFinder Family Services will be responsible for delivering the bags to foster children.
