The Denton Rotary Club provided \$6,000 in financial support to help underwrite the renovation costs of two Supervised Independent Living Homes at the Cumberland Presbyterian Children's Home in Denton, Texas. The two homes required the following renovations: Bathroom updates: two new toilets; one new vanity and paint for the remaining vanities; two hot water heater replacements, replacement of kitchen countertops and backsplashes, and paint countertop painting.

9 Rotarians spent time at at Cumberland Children's Home helping with the renovation. We moved furniture, cleaned surfaces, and painted walls.
