These students and their parents are participants in a program called LOT318 which strives to break the cycle and see opportunities that staying in school will offer them.

Each child will have the tools and supplies to fully participate in the learning environment. Education is a key to positive self-image, empowering the child to seek new opportunities in life and to avoid being drawn into gang-related activities.

LOT318 is a non-profit which coordinates the efforts on behalf of the families in these under-served neighborhoods. It provides the student information, and hosts the distribution ceremony. Individual non-Rotarians donated some of the school supplies.
