Timbers were played to form a footpath to the Pavilion, and crushed rock was placed inside the footpath to form a base material for paving at a later date.

The footpath is only a small aspect of this project, as it will make it possible for wheelchairs to have access to the pavilion and playground pieces our club purchased for installation. The intended beneficiaries are children with disabilities and their families who may be disabled. Of course others can also use the site once completed.

1. Staked out the footpath and played the timbers in place.

2. Filled the footpath area with crushed rock, raked and smoothed out to a consistent depth and used a compactor to prepare the site for later paving when donated material becomes available.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

In-Kind help was provided by Johnson River Enterprises, a local contracting firm. Johnson River provided equipment and operator for contouring the site so the footpath could be played in a level area. Also FNSB Parks and Recreation staff provided assistance as needed by bringing in additional dirt to level the area, and also crushed rock for the parking lot.


