The Fair benefitted homeless, battered and indigent women and their children			
throughout San Diego. Volunteers, including members of our Rotary,			
organized and staffed the event. Over 500 women and children in need were			
assisted. They received medical assistance, legal services, employment and			
vocational counseling along with counseling and assistance obtaining other			
vitally needed services. The funds received were utilized to provide meals,			
coffee and a comfortable seating venue for the women also used to underwrite a			
portion of the cost of transportation and child care to ensure that the women			
had access to the event and to all services.

Implementation of this grant required coordination with SDVLP, the non-profit
