 As of 2/15/15 we have participated in 4 projects with Lot318. The first was a shopping event to WalMart to purchase 2 bikes, helmets and locks. These bikes will be used as an incentive in the homework club. Kids will accrue points throughout the school year and the boy & girl student with the highest amount of points, wins the bike. The 2nd project was not hands on, but we purchased the barricades that Lot318 uses to secure the perimeter of the homework club, events, and food distribution. These events take place on a vacant lot and the street. The 3rd activity was financial support of 4 children to winter camp hosted by a local church. Our club members also participated at the Thanksgiving Day Dinner where they served 2000 homeless/needy individuals and families.
