Training Facilities

The Coaching Center, being constructed at Manickampatti in collaboration with the Government, has advanced to final stages of completion. On completion the training center will be handed over to the Government. The building on completion, will provide a safe learning environment to all the children in the village to impart training on physical development, cognitive enhancement, intellectual advancement and emotional balance.

Towards achieving the objective, AWT, established VKCs with the support of the local villagers. Facilitators have been appointed at each of the 4 VKCs to coordinate the

Evening Supplementary Classes



Supplementary classes are conducted every day evening in 4 centers which is open to all children in the respective villages. The class commences at

5 PM with 1 hour of games, followed by a refreshment break(provided) and thereafter a study time of 2 hours, where home work is monitored and doubts clarified. 194 Students have enrolled for the evening classes that commenced in 4 villages

English & Mathematics Lab

Children in the rural area have been assessed for their proficiency in Mathematics and English. Standard tools developed by the curriculum department have been administered for assessment. Special labs and sessions have been organized for children who have scored less and the sessions are conducted for 3 months. The post-programme assessments has shown improvements in the children's performance. 56 students who needed special attention joined Special Coaching classes for English & Maths

Empowerment Programme for Women and Youth

Enroll Women in Insurance Schemes

Life Skill trainings are organized in the Rotary adopted villages to ensure rural women open bank accounts and also access life insurance schemes. Women are also educated on the various civil and financial entitlements that will facilitate their empowerment. Enrollment is in process.



Youth Club

Efforts are taken to build the capacities of the youth to handle social and environmental issues, especially that they encounter within the village. The youth are being formed as clubs to identify issues and either solve themselves or approach the appropriate government authorities to help them solve.

Parliament



82 Children have enrolled in the 4 villages and formed as Parliaments. As part of the Parliament's initiatives, the members of the Parliament have adopted 88 elders in their respective villages. The members have voiced

14 village level grievances in appropriate forums, so far. During an event, the members paid tribute to the Pulwama Martyrs.

Health Care (Sanitation, Helath Camps etc.,)

Medical Camps

Medical camp was organized at Manickampatti benefitting 122. Awareness on dental hygiene organized benefitting 99 households. Health brigades among children have been formed in 4 villages with a membership of 83.

Tele-Medicine Programme

The project has networked with a local hospital to provide tele-medicine services to the communities and offer special consultations. Connectivity have been checked and pilot activities completed. Schedule of services to the villages are being worked to ensure atleast one tele-medicine camp per village during every fortnight.



Sanitation Awareness

Awareness programmes are organized jointly with the children and youth to ensure construction of household toilets at every house. Meetings are organized to help the community children monitor usage of the existing toilets.

Community Toilets and Water Sources Conservation



Community Sanitation Complex at Musundagiripati

Formalities to acquire land, approval for building plan and proceedings to initiating construction of community toilet at Kathapatti has been completed.

Borework is completed at the site and the yield was gained at 425 ft and the depth of the borewell is 630 ft.

Subsequently the construction site was cleared and construction commenced. Column concrete work is under progress at present.



Smart Class Rooms/ Other Educational Facilities in Schools

Assessment at Government Schools

Assessment has been undertaken at 3 Government Primary Schools to provide Audio-Visual System (AV) and associated furnishing at an estimated cost of 1 Lakhs each. The projects intends to provide educative materials along with the AV system to enable smart learning.
