PROJECT OVERVIEW

In the city of Ensenada BC, Mexico, tap water is not drinkable, the state water commission (CESPE) only cleans and treats the water with chlorine for house and industry use, it's not meant to be drinkable water because it still has minerals and other components that can make you sick if you drink it directly.

MISSION

Support our Community by Providing purified water to students and relatives of low-income (PUBLIC) schools to improve their health by avoiding gastrointestinal diseases.

GOAL

It is intended to install a water purifier system of 400lts in 10 schools with an average of 330 students plus 3 family members per student, so 9,900 people from the urban and sub-urban area of Ensenada would be supported

EXPECTED SAVINGS AND BENEFITS

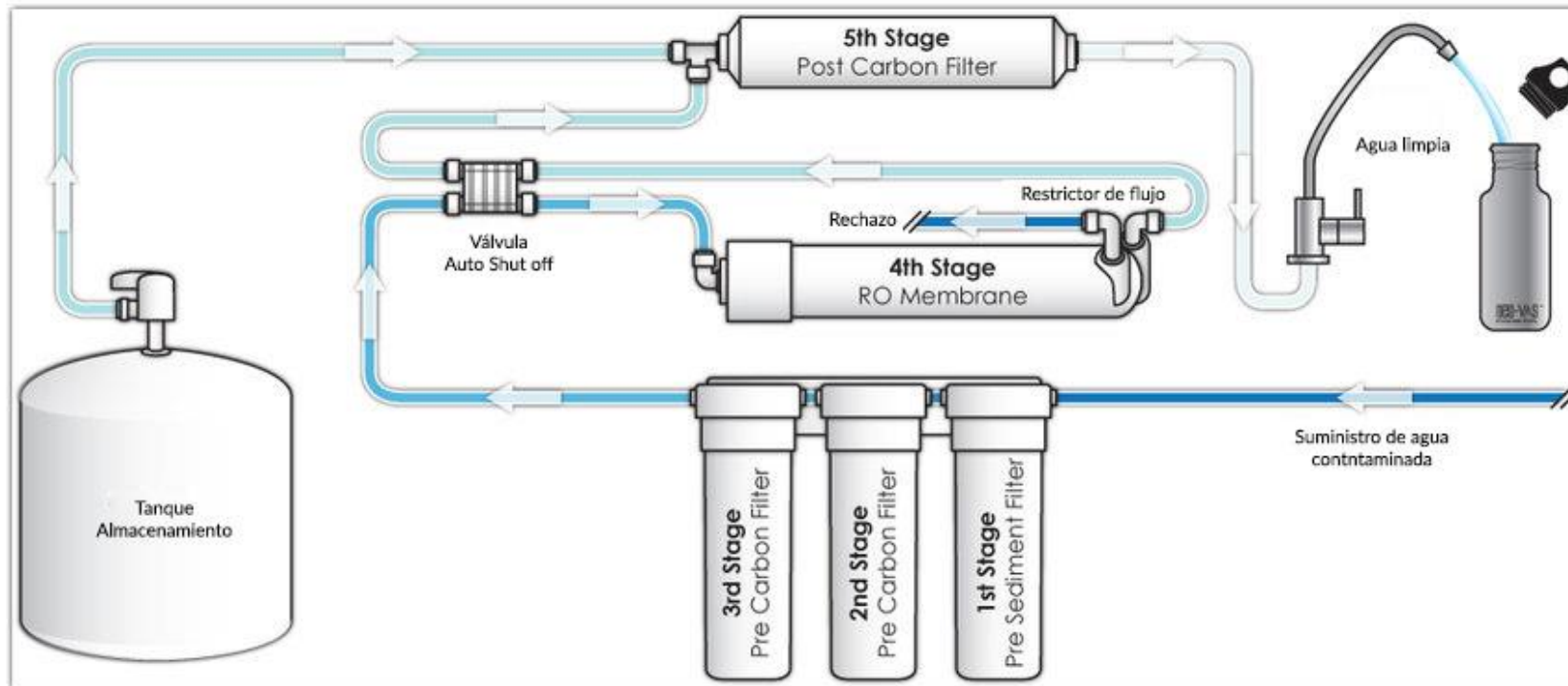
The schools have to buy potable water for the students and faculty. This means that each school has to spend approximately \$57,600 pesos (\$3,031.57 dollars) annually, and for the 10 schools is a total of \$576,000 pesos (\$30,315.70 dollars); money that can be diverted in acquiring school materials or equipment.

Each school uses an average of 800 liters per week; for 40 school weeks' that's 32,000 liters annually.

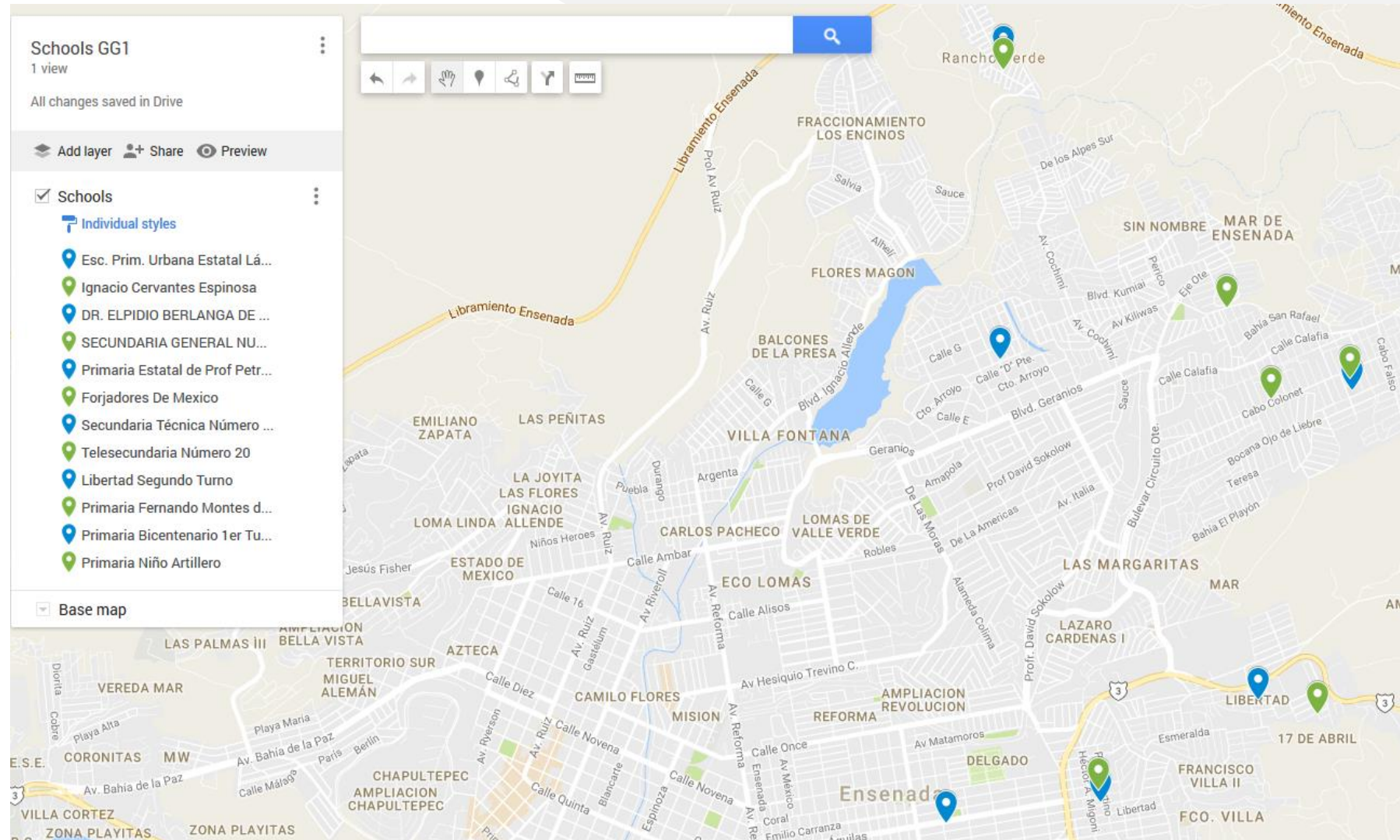

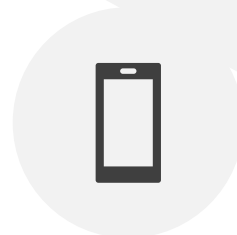
