- famers. Or even other farmers if need arises.
 - 5. Train Arise Africa staff and 200 farmers to form a cooperative where they can save money and access it in form of loans when needed.
- Train Arise Africa staff to help farmers manage their loans well and pay back timely after harvest and sales.
- 7. To educate and train 10 community farmers out of 200, on how to use tractor and its implements,
- 8. To educate and train 10 community farmers about new farming methods and let them use their farms as demonstration farms to other farmers.
- 9. To help train the remaining 190 community farmers currently farming on Arise Africa land using the 10 trained farmers.
- 10. To educate and help 10 community farmers to learn about drought resistant seeds, new farming methods and new ways of soil conservation to improve on food production and income.
- 11. To create a sense of awareness for the local community towards sustainable agriculture production.
- 12. To re-organize 200 farmers in a cooperative and strengthen and work together to achieve increased food production for food and income through proper use of tractor and its implements, fertilizer and improved seeds.
- 13. To allow other farmers out of Arise Africa international to also learn from the 200 farmers.
- 14. To allow schools and young community people to learn from the 200 farmers and Arise Africa farm project.
